How does Book Bingo work?

- Book Bingo is designed for readers in grades K-2. Beginner readers can have books read to them.
- Read a variety of titles that fit descriptions on the Bingo card to complete an entire row – up and down, across, or diagonally – for Bingo.
- Write the title in the corresponding square and the date you completed the book.
- You will be awarded a ticket to the Carmel Cinema for each Bingo completed, for a maximum of five tickets for a Blackout Card (all squares completed).


The details:

- You are on your honor to read books before adding them to your Bingo Card. Only add books read between January and March 2017.
- Suggestions for titles in each category are available at the circulation desk.
- Bingo will run January 9, 2017 through March 31, 2017 or as long as movie ticket supplies last.
- Reed Library employees and trustees are not eligible.
