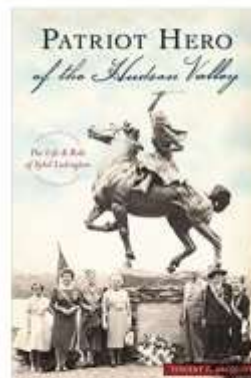

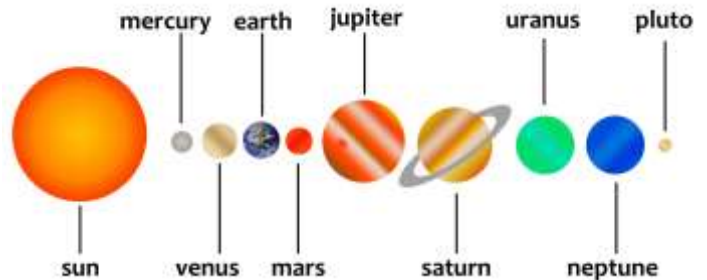
QUE SEURAT, SEURAT Wednesday July 31 at 11 am

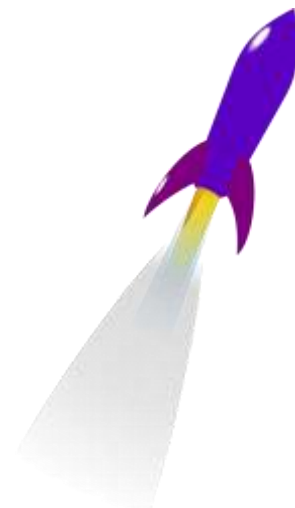
