

MUSEUM PASS BORROWING INFORMATION

Passes are available to library patrons 18 years and older whose record is in good standing. Families and individuals may borrow one pass at a time.

The loan period for a museum pass is seven (7) days. Passes may not be renewed.

Passes must be returned to the Reed Library in the plastic case in which they were received.

A late fee of \$5 per day, up to the cost of the pass, will be imposed for every day the pass is overdue. The replacement cost for lost passes is the museum's charge to the library.

It is the borrower's responsibility to confirm hours of operation, exhibits, parking fees, etc.

We hope you'll come often to visit the Reed Library, located at the intersection of Routes 6 and 52 in the Hamlet of Carmel. Our hours are:

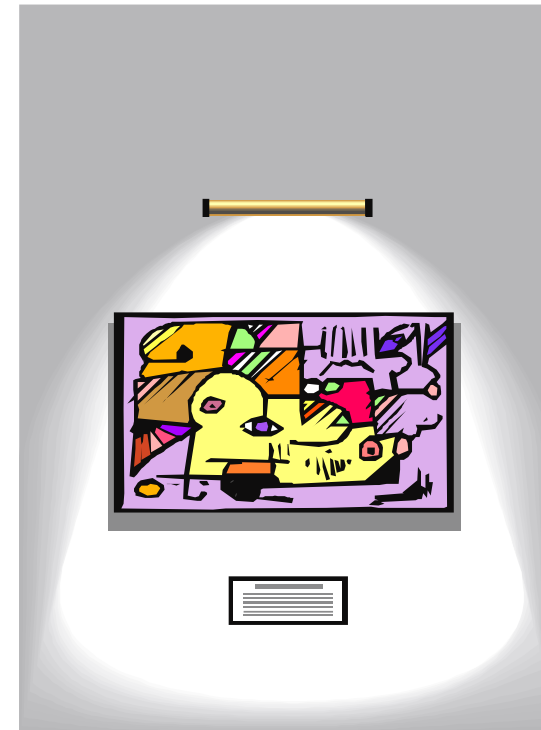

REED MEMORIAL LIBRARY

In addition to museum passes, we offer for loan a large selection of the latest books, CDs, DVDs, magazines, audio books, e-books as well as streaming and downloadable video, music, audio books and magazines. Ancestry.com is available in the library as well as faxing, copying and printing capabilities, public computers and wireless internet access.

The Reed Memorial Library was established by the Literary Union of Carmel which was incorporated in 1883. The Reed Library was built in 1913 in memory of William Belden Reed, an early Literary Union supporter. Beautifully constructed and maintained, the Library continues to bring cultural, educational and recreational opportunities to the Carmel community.

In 1980 the Reed Memorial Library was added to the National Register of Historic Places for its architectural significance.

In 2013 voters approved the establishment of the Reed Memorial Public Library District. Reed's century-long commitment to providing ever-expanding services in an inviting, friendly community center will continue thanks to the support of its community.

The Reed Library is part of the Mid-Hudson Library system, a network of libraries in Putnam, Dutchess, Greene, Columbia and Ulster counties.

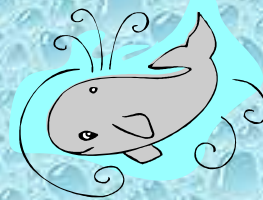

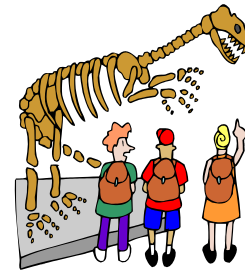

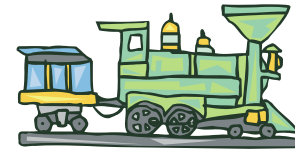
