

## BUILDING UPDATE


The library will be closed through Monday July 4 for building restoration work. This week most of the shoring was put in place and the cracks in the building were mortared to prevent any movement during the lintel removal and replacement. The contractor, architect and doormaker met at the library to carefully go over the details of replacing the doors and doorframe - the measurements, the procedure for replacing the frame, then the doors - and all the intricacies and unknowns of taking an old building apart and putting it back together again. The heavy work will continue next week. Please avoid the building during this time.

If the weather cooperates and all goes as planned, we will reopen on Tuesday July 5 at 10 am. We'll let you know if that changes as soon as we hear, stay tuned!

Mondays July 11th - September 26th at 10:30 am






