6,599 individuals attended 656 programs, many virtually.

Over 36,683 items were loaned including books, music, museum passes, movies, and magazines.



There are 3,908 Reed Library card holders.



Our wireless network was signed into 2,696 times.



Over 45,000 digital and physical items are in our collection.

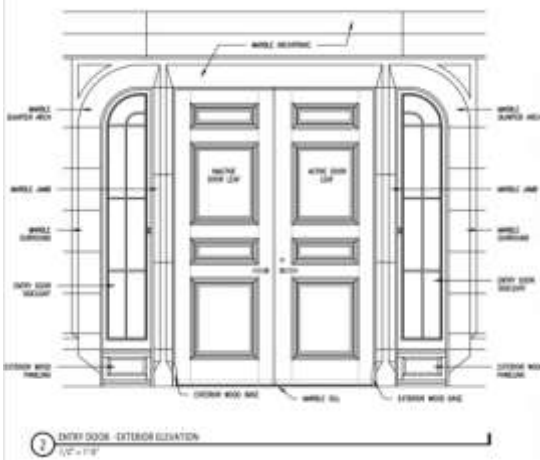


Our website was visited 18,700 times.
